Iarraimis oraibh gan do pháiste a sheoladh isteach mura bhfuil siad maith go leor le bheith ar scoil. There are many children sick at the moment with flu, stomach bug, cold and viral illnesses. Pupils are being sent to school ill and these illnesses are spreading rapidly as a result.
